Wyevale Nursery site visit: learning about trees and shrubs

Cate is a tree warden so she visited the Council's largest supplier of trees and hedging plants. Trees and hedgerows help to capture carbon, reduce emissions and provide habitat for wildlife. The visit included learning about potting and cutting techniques, cold storage, growing on trees in fields and nurseries, pest control and various hi-tech equipment.
